3. Copy of a complete FASFA Student Aid Report or a completed copy of parents 2018 Income Tax statement (*Entire report or return is required.*)
4. Achievement/Activities Form (*Must be completed on the form provided, in the space provided. Additional pages, resumes, or portfolios will not be considered.*)
5. Two Letters of Recommendation (*Must be written by non-relatives. Please remove letters from envelopes to include in packet.*)
6. One-page typed essay answering the following questions: What does financial responsibility mean to you and how do you manage your finances? How will receiving your college degree help improve your financial future and how can Robins Financial Credit Union help you achieve your financial goals? (*Spelling and grammar will be considered.*)
